

McMinnville Company Presents Governor with Recycled Bench

Governor Phil Bredeson is the first governor of Tennessee, perhaps in the nation, to own a park bench made out of recycled household garbage.

The bench, which is now on display in the State's Capitol, was presented to the governor by BouldinCorp, a McMinnville-based resource recycler.

“Aside from the metal legs, this bench is 100% recycled household garbage from Warren County,” commented Floyd Bouldin, CEO of BouldinCorp. “We’re very excited about the many products that will be developed from our recycling and extruding processes.”

Perhaps more exciting than its product development potential is the fact that BouldinCorp represents a real solution to America's landfill crisis. For more than a year, the company has received unsorted, household garbage from Warren County and using a proprietary method has processed the garbage into useful, recycled products.

The benefit to Warren County? The garbage no longer gets transferred to a landfill. That fact has received attention from many other U.S. communities, over a dozen foreign countries and the Department of Defense. The company is currently in negotiations with Coffee and Putnam Counties among several others outside of Tennessee to establish garbage recycling systems.

With BouldinCorp's help, Warren County far surpassed the federal mandate of 25% municipal waste recycling. Today, they are recycling over 95%. This high level of recycling has resulted in Warren County already receiving over \$200,000 in state recycling grants. Bouldin says it's just a matter of time before other communities can benefit from the same situation.

“Some people think that there's no viable alternative to landfills,” stated Bouldin. “We happen to know different, and we've been proving it for over a year now.” With the help of many middle Tennessee investors and state officials, the process has undergone continuous and remarkable improvements during its first municipal contract.
